Chapter 1: The Ascendant

The precise time on the day of your birth determines your particular Ascendant, also known as your Rising Sign. This was the zodiac sign that was rising over the horizon when you were born. In addition to your Sun and Moon Sign, the Rising Sign reveals very important traits that make up a major part of your personality and your individual approach to life. This is usually the impression you like to make before you really get to know someone; it is your outer personality and image.

Libra Rising:

There is a distinct part of your outer personality that expresses itself very much like a Libra. You are charming, diplomatic, prefer cooperation to competition and people know you for your easy-going manner.

Since this was the sign of the zodiac that was rising over the horizon at your time of birth, the principle of Libra--relating to others--will be integrated into almost every area of life in some way.

Venus is your chart ruler. To discover even more about what's a priority for you, and also, the first impression you make on others, read everything in the chapter on Venus.

Mercury Conjunct or in hard aspect to Asc.:

The way that you communicate can either make or break the first impression that you make on others. Perfect the art of conversation and develop a sincere ability to really listen to what others have to say.

You're a talker and an idea person. You have a curious mind and have probably researched a wide variety of subjects. Naturally then, you know how to carry on a decent conversation about a broad range of topics.

You have a youthful outlook on life and you know all about the latest trends, even if you don't actively participate in them.

Jupiter Conjunct or in hard aspect to Asc.:

You can attract others with your playful, outgoing, zest-for-living attitude. You're fun to be around and other people enjoy your antics. You have the ability to dramatize certain situations, and other people get a kick out of letting you be the one to act out what they wish they had the nerve to do themselves.

Make a space for compromise and tolerance. You can get carried away with your own sense of right and wrong.

Uranus in soft aspect to Asc.:

You're a character. At least that's the first impression other people get. Even within the confines of a group, you stand out as unique in some way. When all is said and done, your will is the last word. You have an unpredictable streak in you and other people find you exciting because they never know for sure what you'll do or say next.

Neptune Conjunct or in hard aspect to Asc.:

You can be whatever you can imagine yourself to be, so, make sure you only imagine the best! You may have some inner doubts about yourself that make it difficult for others to pick up a strong impression of whom you really are. Until you cultivate a firmer picture of whom you really want to be, other people will continue to find it hard to figure out the real you. This can be a plus if you're an actor or a spy. It comes in handy if you ever need to blend into the background, too.

Pluto in soft aspect to Asc.:

Chapter 2: The Sun

The Sun cannot be ignored. We must meet and deal with the area of life that the Sun shines on in our chart in order to find ultimate fulfillment. Everything revolves around the Sun. When you master whatever issues the Sun points to, then other areas of life will proceed in a more balanced and satisfactory manner. The Sun also represents: your own will, major goals, the father, men in your life, children, creativity, and the real inner you.

Sun in Cancer:

Moon Conjunct or in hard aspect to Sun:

Most likely there existed some kind of tension between your parents. Even if this was not openly expressed, you picked up on it as a child. Chapter 3: The Moon

The Moon in your chart represents the past and points to an area of life (the house) where we function out of instinctive awareness. Often we have a deep emotional need to do the things that the Moon's house placement represents. Whenever insecurities arise and our feelings become involved, we tend to bring the traits (the sign) of our Moon into play. The Moon is like our security blanket. It also represents: the home, females in your life, the mother, nurturing others or being nurtured ourselves, as well as things related to the domestic scene in general.

Moon in Cancer:

Moon in 10th house:

Chapter 4: Mercury

Mercury is the planet of communication. It tells us about how we think and talk. You can gain insight into your mode of gathering, processing and transmitting information from Mercury's placement in your chart. Mercury also represents: transportation, the five senses, youth, reading, and writing.

Mercury in Cancer:

Intuitive, expressive and somewhat changeable in nature, you have an active and creative imagination that can be put to very positive use if you choose. Try not to use it to create imaginary slights from others that will only cause you unnecessary disappointment.

This placement makes you easily swayed by emotional states, whether they originate within yourself or are generated by other people.

For some people, shyness may be an obstacle to overcome at some point in life. This timidity does not necessarily come from lack of self-esteem. It often stems from an instinctive need to protect your naturally sensitive emotions from the onslaught of a sometimes too chaotic environment.

Mercury in 9th house:

You enjoy philosophical conversations and you like to share your knowledge with others. You see the big picture and you may even have "prophetic visions" that accurately portray future trends.

Jupiter Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

You may experience an inner conflict at times between acting on logic and acting on pure faith.

You express yourself well, but there is sometimes a tendency to be overly verbose due to the fact that you doubt your own ability to get your point across satisfactorily. People do understand more of what you say than you may think they do.

Really grasping what you hear can be challenging for you because your mind often likes to race ahead of the subject at hand.

Neptune Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

Rational, logical thought patterns can conflict with intuitive perceptions. This means that you may not trust your own intuition simply because there is no rational explanation to back it up.

Sometimes when you're verbalizing your thoughts, you can go on into infinity. However, at other times when you withdraw into your own mental "attic" you can become very quiet, giving others the impression that you're spaced out.

With this aspect it is important for you to cultivate inner conviction by eradicating doubts and irrational fears. Avoid indulging in self defeating words or thoughts, as they may eventually manifest as tangible events. Instead, use your mind to imagine the best and reap the rewards of positive thinking.

Chapter 5: Venus

Venus is the planet of relating to others, and thus is associated with love, attraction and socializing. In a male's chart, Venus can provide clues about traits he finds attractive in females. In a female's chart, it reveals something about how she relates to males. Venus is also the planet of material goodies and sensual delights in all of their various forms. Venus also represents: money, harmonious conditions, pleasurable activities, beauty, and the arts.

Venus in Gemini:

See how a butterfly flits from flower to flower? That's often the Venus in Gemini approach. Venus in 9th house:

Foreign people, places and things tend to be beneficial for you in the long run and you might even marry someone from overseas.

You are expansive in matters of love and you enjoy being generous when you have a little something extra to spread around.

Mars in soft aspect to Venus:

You are lively and demonstrative. You know how to work for and not against yourself.

Sensuality can be quite pronounced with this aspect. Do you ever find that people are staring at you? There is something attractively magnetic about your auric field that demands the attention of other people, even though you're not trying to do that intentionally.

Chapter 6: Mars

Mars is our planet of action, energy output, motivation, and instinctive biological drives. It shows how and in which area of life you are willing to put forth a lot of effort. Mars' energy is quick, impulsive, and survival oriented. In a male's chart, Mars reveals something about how he relates to females. In a female's chart, Mars can provide clues about the traits she finds attractive in males. Mars also represents: competitive situations, conflicts, accidents, and sexual energies.

Mars in Leo:

Chapter 7: Jupiter

Jupiter in Cancer:

Jupiter in 10th house:

This can also indicate that you will have more than your share of having to be responsible for other people in some way. If this is true, don't worry. You can definitely handle it.

Chapter 8: Saturn

Saturn also represents: life lessons to be learned, trials and tests, a strong sense of duty, and bringing ideas into material form.

Saturn in Gemini:

Saturn in 9th house:

Uranus Conjunct or in hard aspect to Saturn:

As soon as you begin to feel comfortable with your station in life or your achievements, unforeseen circumstances often arise that prod you into activity and forward movement again.

You take yourself too seriously at times and you avoid putting yourself into subordinate positions at work or in any other group situation. If you can sit back and look at life with a different perspective, you will be able to see the value of the humorous side of life especially as it applies to you.

Lighten up on your fellow man while you're at it. Those who share your capacity for progressive thinking and inventive approaches may be hard to come by, so you may as well make up your mind to go with the flow. Your visions will manifest more efficiently with the support of others.

Pluto in soft aspect to Saturn:

Self discipline and endurance are traits that you will continue to perfect throughout life. It's easy for you to become compulsive about your ambitions once a decision is made. Chapter 9: Uranus

Uranus is a planet of unexpected change and unpredictable events. It tells us something about where we have unusual ideas and how we want to express our own unique individuality. Uranus in Gemini:

When you read your individual house placement for Uranus, you will be able to see where these traits will express themselves on a more personal basis.

Uranus in 9th house:

You can be a genius when it comes to understanding abstract concepts that make other people's heads swim.

Your ideas about God are unusual and you have strong leanings toward the unorthodox viewpoint.

Sudden awakenings come to you through visions and your intuition is prophetic especially with respect to the big picture.

You could find yourself doing some last minute travels in a foreign country. Long distance journeys will bring some highly unusual experiences. Expect the unexpected.

Pluto in soft aspect to Uranus:

You came into being at a time when forceful transitions were the order of the day. You'll fight to the bitter end for what you perceive to be societal injustices. Those in this generation have strong feelings for the underdog and a deep awareness of the need for reforming change at many levels of the society they live in.

Your personal regenerative powers can be tremendous. You may be someone who takes extreme measures when it comes to preserving your sense of individuality and freedom. Compromise in this area doesn't come naturally by any means.

Chapter 10: Neptune

Neptune is a planet that dissolves hard and fast boundaries. It is where we don't always see things as they really are, mostly because we would rather view the world through rose-colored glasses.

With Neptune, anything becomes a possibility, especially that which we can imagine. Neptune also represents: tuning into other planes of reality, the spiritual dimensions, cosmic consciousness, movies, music, and inspired creativity.

Neptune in Virgo:

Because Neptune stays in the same sign about fourteen years, there are many other people who will experience the same things that this placement brings to varying degrees. Some of these include: an "I'll believe it when I see it" attitude, especially directed toward mystical occurrences, a desire to heal yourself psychologically and the

desire to serve humanity by helping people to elevate themselves in practical ways.

Your house position will show where Neptune affects your life on an individual basis.

Neptune in 12th house:

You have a soft spot inside for the underdog and you can easily empathize with the suffering of your fellow man.

You avoid unpleasant realities by tuning them out. This can take the form of psychological denial or, in the extreme case, the use of addictive escapes. Mind altering drugs are best avoided.

This placement can indicate a strong influence from past lives that is carried over into this lifetime and you may be someone who receives vivid past life impressions. Professional past life regression can often help to heal any chronic psychological unrest.

Chapter 11: Pluto

Pluto is a planet that brings with it transformation. Something about the area of life that it points to will undergo a complete change. Significant lifestyle changes can happen whenever Pluto is involved. Deep, complex issues will be brought to light eventually. It is where conditions can swing from one extreme to the other. It's all or nothing.

Pluto also represents: psychological probing, keeping secrets or bringing them to light, power and control issues, obsessions, healing and purification.

Pluto in Leo:

Pluto is the slowest moving planet, and thus is recognized as exerting a generational influence as it moves through each zodiac sign.

With Pluto in Leo you're part of the generation that can experience radical changes in leisure time activities and its own children. On a personal level, those with Pluto in Leo tend to be proud, into hero worship and self centered in the sense of making their personal desires all important.

Read the house placement for Pluto in your chart. It shows you an area of life where this planet has a more personal influence.

Pluto in 11th house:

You have ideas about creating the perfect utopian society and you feel the ills of the world deeply. It wouldn't be surprising if you ended up joining a group dedicated to world change in one form or another. Be aware, though, that this placement can find you being asked to give up your individual identity in favor of the group mind. Power and control issues can surface also.

You may go through periods in life where you find yourself surrounded by people and at other times you wonder where everyone went. Connections with others often begin with intensity and then end in strange circumstances. This the house of acquaintances more so than best friends.

Chapter 12: Elements, the North Node, and the Midheaven

In this section of the report we interpret the following astrological influences: the Moon's North Node, the MC (the 10th house cusp or Midheaven) and also a preponderance of an astrological element. A "preponderance" occurs when 4 or more planets or the Ascendant is in that element: fire, earth, air, or water. Many people do not have a heavy emphasis of a particular element so not everyone will have an interpretation of an element emphasis.

If the individual chart has aspects to the MC, these will reveal certain career options and potentials for your consideration.

The North Node is an important pointer along the pathway of life. You'll have to be willing to stretch yourself and move away from familiar patterns in order to meet the challenge of the North Node. Great rewards will be reaped in the form of personal growth and reaching your potential goals. The North Node sign will suggest an approach to the area of life represented by its house position.

North Node in Virgo:

Incorporating the following traits into your life will make it easier in the long run to attain goals.

The best way to describe this principle is to imagine a bird having to leave its nest for the first time. It is extremely challenging, but it's the only way to really learn to fly.

Learn that it's O.K. to say no. This is a lifetime to learn all about separating what is useful from what is not. You can be an expert at logical analysis. Tie up loose ends and get yourself organized.

Worry and anxiety can be held at bay by making yourself useful. Active participation in life, especially helping other people, will keep your mind at ease and your energy high. Pay attention to health messages from your body.

Discover that dealing with mundane responsibilities and disagreeable chores, instead of putting them off, can actually create its own kind of freedom.

North Node in 12th house:

The universe is encouraging you to play up the aforementioned traits in these areas of life.

Consider the following: give of yourself without an underlying motivation of reward. Practice random acts of kindness... just because you can.

Discover that it's possible to be alone and not feel lonely. This happens when one realizes their connection to the Infinite Mind, also described as the Creator, the Universal Will, or a Higher Power.

This is a lifetime to learn the value of working behind the scenes in some capacity. This means that outer recognition is not the aim this time around, even though that might happen naturally. Often this can take the form of connecting and working through large public institutions caring for those who must be secluded from society.

Whatever form the actual experiences take, this placement encourages the development of humility, compassion and spiritual awareness.

MC Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

You'll have to come up with some clever ploys to get your ideas noticed by those at the top level, but you have the ingenuity to figure it out. Some of your inspiration, although excellent, conflicts with the boss's own ideas. Rely on persistence and don't let rejection pull the plug on your enthusiasm.

Variety is the key to your career. Either a variety of careers, or perhaps a medley of duties to perform within a single career.
